

## Golf News

The new World Handicap System (WHS) will be launched in early January. An information session for our golf members is scheduled for **3pm January 3rd at the clubhouse** - see your email for more details. Your league leaders are your first point of contact for questions.

Please note that there is a new version of the course scorecards now available in the golf shop, which has a changed handicap index order for both men and women. Please dispose of any old versions of the scorecard to avoid confusion when calculating the new net double-bogey maximum score for each hole.

For golf members who have paid the 2020 trail fee to use their private golf carts on the course, please collect a green trail fee sticker from the sales office and display it on the passenger side of the cart front window. Private carts not displaying a trail fee sticker are not allowed on the course or the cart paths at any time.



Save the Dates for our June Member Golf Tournaments. For Member/Guest teams only, there will be a two-day 36-hole event on Friday June 19th and Saturday June 20th 2020, with separate flights for men and ladies. All teams in this two-day event must be comprised of either two men or two ladies, and all teams must be a member with a guest. Alternatively, there will be a one-day flexible Summer Solstice Tournament on Saturday June 20th 2020, run along similar lines to the event we had in 2019 with 9-hole or 18-hole formats. Teams can be a member with a guest, or two members playing together. Teams can be two men, two ladies or a mixed couple.
